The new faculty will enhance our current strengths and expertise in the biomedical/molecular area, providing instruction to average class sizes of less than 30 students. Two of the available positions are additions to the faculty as a result of Longwood’s newly established Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program. All positions are Assistant Professor rank and anticipated to begin August 2010. The University will provide dedicated research space in the new Chichester Science Center as well as modest start-up funding. Successful candidates will have:

- An earned Ph.D. in a related area;
- Strong commitment to excellence and innovation in undergraduate teaching;
- The potential to develop a successful research program in an undergraduate setting;
- Demonstrated experience advising students and supervising undergraduate research; and
- Commitment to service to the university and local communities.

Successful candidates must be able to contribute to one or more of the following teaching responsibilities: Human Anatomy and Physiology, Cell Biology, Genetics, and Microbiology. Additional opportunities exist for teaching introductory biology for majors and non-majors as well as upper-level courses in other areas of expertise.
