Qualifications for Applicants

One student will be selected each year in the College of Business and Economics to receive this scholarship. The scholarship may be renewed for the senior year upon application and selection.

- A. Applicants must have earned at least 45 semester credit hours, 30 of which were earned at Longwood. Applicants must have completed ACCT 240 and either ECON 217 or ECON 218 with grades of at least "C" in those courses.
- B. Applicants must be a Business Administration or Economics major (or pre-business or pre-economics).
- C. Applicants must have at least a 2.5 GPA and financial need.
- D. Applicants must be rising juniors or seniors.
- E. Student participation in school, college, and community activities will be considered.
- F. Applicants must agree that, if selected, their grades can be released to Mrs. Coleman.
- G. Applicants must agree that, if selected, they will send a note of appreciation to Mrs. Coleman.

Application & Selection Process

Applicants must:

- Attach a copy of their resume.
- Write a business letter indicating their career goals and describing their participation in school, college and community activities, especially those while at Longwood University.

Submit application form, resume, and letter to Hiner 105-1 no later than February 14.

The committee will screen the applications and may select three to five candidates to interview before final selection of the winners. The scholarship award announcements will be made in April.
