Qualifications for Applicants

Each year the CBE Student Awards Committee will select a declared accounting, business education, or economics student for the O'Brien Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship may be renewed upon application and selection.

- A. Applicants must be a Business Administration major (or pre-business) with a concentration in accounting, business education, or economics; or an Economics major (or pre-economics).
- B. Applicants must have at least a 2.5 GPA and financial need.
- C. Special consideration will be given for service in university or community activities, especially those involving children
- D. Applicants must agree that, if selected, they will send a note of appreciation to the O'Brien family.

Application & Selection Process

Applicants must:

- Attach a copy of their resume.
- Write a business letter indicating their career goals and describing their participation in school, college and community activities, especially those while at Longwood University.

Submit application form, resume, and letter to Hiner 105-1 no later than February 14.

The committee will screen the applications and may select three to five candidates to interview before final selection of the winners. The scholarship award announcements will be made in April.
