

# DISCUSSION GROUPS

One of the unfortunate aspects of a large class is the absence of opportunity for every student to join actively in discussions. Some students are too shy to speak out in class. Consequently, small group discussions will be arranged. These discussion groups are limited in size, and students should sign up a week in advance.

Each student is required to attend a minimum of 5 discussions during the semester (attendance will be taken). The student may attend more sessions, of course. These small group discussions will be facilitated by student assistants. In advance of the session you plan to attend, send an email message to him/her indicating specific questions or issues you would like to discuss. On occasion, the instructor may request reports from small group discussions to be presented during the next scheduled class.
