## Student Research Notes:

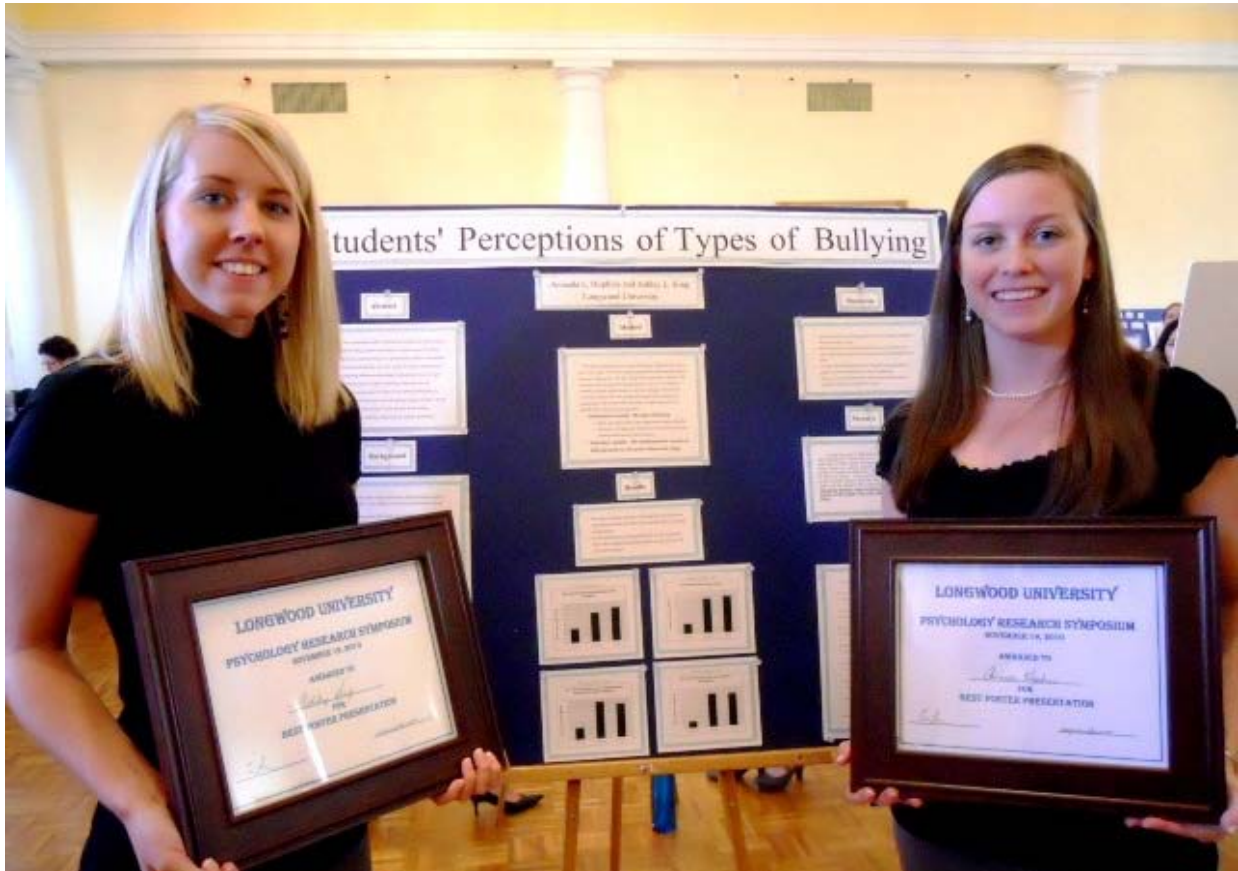
