Internship Credit

- What are the pre-requisites before completing an internship?

Answer:

- 1) The student must have completed 24 credits in Communication Studies with a minimum GPA of 2.5.
 - 2) The student must have completed a resume workshop and consultation and an interviewing workshop and practice interview with a member of the Longwood University Academic & Career Advising Center staff. This must be completed no later than April 1 (Prior to Spring Break is highly recommended).
 - 3) The student must complete and submit an Internship Proposal Form (available through the Communication Studies Department) no later than May 1.
 - 4) The student must submit (along with the Internship Approval Form) a 2 – 3 page proposal for the internship which addresses the following issues
- What course do students register for if they are completing an internship?
Answer: COMM 492
