Longwood University seeks qualified applicants for a tenure-track assistant professorship in Science Education to begin Fall 2010 pending funding. Primary teaching responsibilities include conceptual physics and scientific method courses for elementary and/or secondary education students. Supervision of student teachers and the ability/willingness to administer NCATE accreditation and science education assessment is also required. Scholarship with undergraduates is expected.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Ph.D. or Ed.D. in science education required;
- Minimum of 18 graduate hours in a scientific discipline taught at Longwood (preferably physics) required;
- Secondary science teaching experience preferred.

Complete applications should include a cover letter, curriculum vita, statement of teaching philosophy, undergraduate scholarship plans (including start-up requirements), unofficial copies of graduate and undergraduate transcripts, and letters of recommendation from three references.
