The Department of Nursing seeks applications for a **full-time tenure-track Associate Professor** for the new Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at Longwood University in Farmville, VA. The mission of Longwood's BSN program is to promote excellence in nursing education and clinical competency; to promote the development of citizen leaders in the nursing profession; to promote partnerships to enhance health care and health care education in the region; to be one component of the solution to the nursing shortage; and to improve the health of local communities. The successful candidate will teach courses in a four year pre-licensure BSN nursing program. Responsibilities will also include curriculum development and evaluation, academic advising, clinical teaching and oversight, scholarly activity, participation in faculty development activities, and service in the local community.

Requirements include a doctorate degree in nursing or related field; must be licensed as RN in Virginia or eligible for such licensure; experience teaching in a BSN program strongly desired; and current clinical expertise. Any nursing specialty considered, but medical/surgical, obstetrics, or pediatrics preferred. A successful background check is required.
