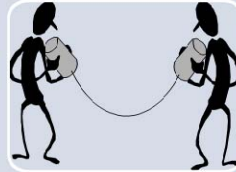


**Security Spotlight:** *RESPECT AND PROTECT THE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY OF OTHERS.*

The Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) was signed



into law on August 14, 2008. Final regulations were issued October 29, 2009 which included three general requirements: disclosure, plan, and alternatives.



### Disclosure

- Remind users annually about copyright law and campus policies related to violating copyright law.



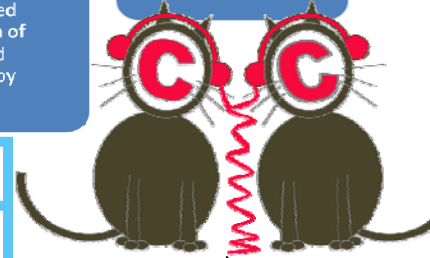
### Plan

- Have a plan to "effectively combat the unauthorized distribution of copyrighted materials" by users.



### Alternatives

- Offer alternatives to illegal downloading.
