THE COMMUNITY ACHIEVEMENT IN THE ARTS AWARD

PURPOSE: Each year the Advisory Board of the Longwood Center for the Visual Arts honors an individual, a business, and an organization that have made a significant and selfless contribution to the development of the arts in Southside Virginia (including Amelia, Appomattox, Buckingham, Charlotte, Cumberland, Lunenburg, Nottoway, and Prince Edward Counties). By making the award, the Advisory Board wishes to encourage increased participation in and support for the arts in our region.

GUIDELINES: Efforts by nominees may have contributed to the visual, performing, and literary arts and must have had an ongoing impact on the community (e.g., community building, education, program development, youth services). The candidates for the individual award must have made a quality contribution in their own area of art as well as volunteering or mentoring services in their specialties. Their contributions should be those outside paid work. Any business is eligible. The organization may be a service or an artistic organization. One nominator may submit as many separate nominations as desired. Previous honorees are ineligible. The Nomination Committee considers candidates from the previous year who have not been honored.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Nominees will be rated according to their ongoing community impact in the following areas: educating/advocating, program development, youth services, adult services, mentoring, volunteering, staff development/presentations, workshops, lectures, and community outreach. Work for paid positions cannot be considered. The applications will be voted on by a committee composed of members of the LCVA Advisory Board's Membership and Marketing Committee.
