Many students use the summer to catch up or get ahead on their credits. While many of them do take courses here at Longwood, many need to consider their local community college options. This is a much more effective discussion when it includes an advisor or department chair!

While there are many courses that will transfer back to Longwood, there are a few things that students need to remember. (1) Please do not take courses that they would like to retake here—credits transfer, but grades do not! (2) They MUST stop by their dean's office and get a Transfer Authorization form. This will make sure that they are taking courses that will help them long term. (3) As soon as their summer course is completed, please ask the Registrar at that school to send the transcripts to the Registrar's office at Longwood. This will reduce later problems with pre-requisite courses.
