<p><i>Strongly recommend that student take the VCLA exam prior to transferring unless SAT/ACT scores meet the requirement to have the test waived. You will need qualifying test scores for admission into the teacher preparation program. - Must be admitted into the Teacher Preparation program before being allowed to take 300-400 level EDUC courses.
- Must meet the GPA requirement (see Education and Teaching website for more information) in both their liberal studies major and overall to be eligible for Student Teaching placement. Students must also be formally admitted into the Teacher Preparation program and have at least a “C” in ENGL 150 (RBC – ENGL 101).
- Transfer students should meet requirements and apply for admission to Teacher Prep by March 1 or October 1 of her/his second semester at Longwood.
