Longwood university board of visitors to consider tuition and fees for 2023-2024 academic year

The Longwood University Board of Visitors will meet at the Stallard Ballroom in Eason Hall at Longwood University on Friday, May 19, 2023 at 3 p.m. The Board is expected to take action on tuition and mandatory fees for the 2023-2024 academic year. Tuition and E&G fee increases of between 0 and 5 percent and auxiliary fee increases of between \$0 and \$12 per credit hour will be considered.

Revenue from any tuition and fee increase will support state-mandated faculty and staff compensation and benefit increases, as well as inflationary cost increases for materials and services.

The Board will accept public comment at the beginning of the meeting prior to any vote on tuition and fees.
