ONLY CURRENT RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE HOUSING REGISTRATION PROCESS

Important highlights regarding housing registration & off-campus housing intent process.

- The process to pull-in roommates during the housing registration process has **CHANGED**. Students will need to establish a roommate group through a form in the student housing gateway prior to their designated registration date. One student will establish the group through the use of the Roommate Group Form to invite students to join the group. Those invited students must utilize the Roommate Group Form to accept the invitation to join the group. It is very important that all students accept the invitation to join the group prior to the designated day to register for housing. Only group members that have accepted the invitation can be "pull-in" as roommates during the housing registration process by the designated roommate.
- The "C" bedroom at Longwood Village will be utilized as a double occupancy room to meet the demand for Longwood managed housing. The "C" bedroom will be offered at a reduced housing rate to provide students with an economical housing option. Therefore, all Longwood Village apartments will be 4-person apartments. - When Frazer Hall is closed for renovations during the 2018-2019 academic year, there will be space in other main campus residence halls for continuing students; however the amount of space will be limited. If the space in main campus residence halls is filled during the registration process, it is possible that some students that prefer to be assigned to a main campus residence hall will be assigned to a Longwood managed apartment space. Every attempt will be made to meet student preferences for housing, but it is not possible to accommodate every student's preference. All students that participate in the housing registration process will receive a housing assignment. There is sufficient space available to meet the demand for Longwood managed housing.
- All students with less than 48 completed credits at the conclusion of the spring 2018 semester **must** participate in the Longwood managed housing registration process to live in a Longwood managed apartment or main campus residence hall.
- Only **continuing residential students** (student's assigned to Longwood managed housing during the spring 2018 semester) are eligible to participate in the Longwood managed apartment registration process to live at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Longwood Landings, and Longwood Village or the Main Campus housing registration process to live in a residence hall.
- Students that register to live in Longwood managed housing are signing a legally binding agreement. It is recommended that students review the housing terms and conditions available at www.longwood.edu/housing prior to participating in the housing registration process.
- Only students with 48 or greater completed Longwood credits at the conclusion of the spring 2018 semester are eligible to submit an Off-Campus Housing Intent form to notify the RCL office that the student plans to live off-campus with a private landlord. Those students intending to live off-campus with a private landlord should review the information regarding the Off-Campus Housing Intent process.

Off- Campus Housing Intent Process to live with a private landlord

Submit intent form January 29th – February 2nd. All intent forms must be received by 5:00pm on Friday, February 2nd. Beginning on January 29th, the intent form can be found in the student housing gateway <https://rms.longwood.edu:446/page/studenthousinggateway>. **YOU MUST ENABLE POP-UPS in your web browser.**

Important Facts about the Off- Campus Housing Intent Process:

- Students must have earned at least **48 credits** at the conclusion of the spring 2018 semester to submit an intent form to notify the RCL office that the student plans to live off-campus with a private landlord.
- Those students with at least 48 credits at the conclusion of the spring 2018 semester that submit the housing intent form during the designated notification process will be eligible to live outside University housing and sign a lease with a private landlord.
- Students are required to provide the Registrar office with an up-to-date local mailing address.
- Any student that submits a housing intent form to live off-campus with a private landlord will not be permitted to participate in the Longwood managed housing registration process and will remain a commuter student while enrolled at the University.

Monday, February 12	"Squatting" Day Return to the Same	Designated roommate must be currently assigned to the actual apartment unit. <u>Full apartment occupancy is required at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, and Landings to squat the apartment.</u>
Tuesday, February 13	Studio Apartment	<u>Only Longwood Village residents are eligible to squat the apartment without full occupancy due to the double bedroom, but are encouraged to fill the apartment to full occupancy. Any open spaces within Longwood Village squatted apartment units will be assigned to other students by the RCL office.</u>
Wednesday, February 14	2 Bedroom Apartment 4 Bedroom Apartment 4 Person LWV Apartment	
	ONLY continuing residential students are eligible to live at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village. Registration will be conducted from 10am to 4pm through the student housing gateway.	
Monday, February 12	"Studio Lottery Application" Day	The lottery application will be available at https://rms.longwood.edu:446/page/studenthousinggateway from February 12th through February 14th at 4pm. All online lottery submissions must be received by February 14th at 4pm. Applicants will be notified regarding lottery results by 12noon on Thursday, February 15th.
Tuesday, February 13	Landings Studio Single & Lancer Park Studio Single	ONLY continuing residential students with 56 or greater Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester are eligible to submit a lottery application.

Monday, February 19	Senior Apartment Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned at least 89 Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residents within the selected apartment unit. <u>Full occupancy is required at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village to register for the apartment unit.</u> Registration will be conducted from 10am to 4pm through the student housing gateway.
	2 Bedroom Apartment 4 Bedroom Apartment 4 Person LWV Apartment	ONLY continuing residential students are eligible to live at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village and MUST fill the apartment to full occupancy to register for the unit.
Tuesday, February 20	Junior Apartment Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned at least 56 Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residents within the selected apartment unit. <u>Full occupancy is required at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village to register for the apartment unit.</u> Registration will be conducted from 10am to 4pm through the student housing gateway.
	2 Bedroom Apartment 4 Bedroom Apartment 4 Person LWV Apartment	ONLY continuing residential students are eligible to live at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village and MUST fill the apartment to full occupancy to register for the unit.
Wednesday, February 21	Sophomore Apartment Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned at least 25 Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residents within the selected apartment unit. <u>Full occupancy is required at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village to register for the apartment unit.</u> Registration will be conducted from 10am to 4pm through the student housing gateway.
	2 Bedroom Apartment 4 Bedroom Apartment 4 Person LWV Apartment	ONLY continuing residential students are eligible to live at Lancer Park, Lancer Park North & South, Landings, and Longwood Village and MUST fill the apartment to full occupancy to register for the unit.
Friday, February 23	Waitlist Apartment waitlist available	Any continuing residential student that was unable to register for an apartment space is eligible to submit a waitlist application. The waitlist application will be available in the student housing gateway on Feb. 23rd. When additional spaces become available, RCL will contact applicants. Applications will be rank ordered by completed credit hours.

Monday, March 19	Sophomore Room Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned between 40-55 Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residential students within the selected main campus room. <u>Full room occupancy required.</u> Female students register 10am-1pm & Male students register 1pm-4pm.
Tuesday, March 20	Sophomore Room Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned between 25-39 Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residential students within the selected main campus room. <u>Full room occupancy required.</u> Female students register 10am-1pm & Male students register 1pm-4pm.
Wednesday, March 21	Freshmen Room Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned 24 or less Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residential students within the selected main campus room. <u>Full room occupancy required.</u> Female students register 10am-1pm & Male students register 1pm-4pm.
Thursday, March 22	Solo Residents Freshmen & Sophomores	Students with 55 or less Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester that cannot fill a room to full occupancy must submit housing and meal plan preferences for an assignment and will be notified of this assignment by RCL.
Monday, March 26	Junior & Senior Room Selection Day	Designated roommate must have earned 56 or greater Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester in order to assign self and other residential students within the selected main campus room. <u>Full room occupancy required.</u> Female students register 10am-1pm & Male students register 1pm-4pm.
Tuesday, March 27	Main Campus Waitlist and Solo Residents (Juniors & Seniors)	In the event that the supply of main campus beds is exhausted or students cannot fill a room to full occupancy, continuing residents with 56 or greater Longwood credits at the conclusion of the Spring 2018 semester may submit housing and meal plan preferences for an assignment and will be notified of this assignment by RCL.
