Gingko Biloba
Gift of the Class of 2005
Before Ruffner Hall was destroyed by fire in 2001, there was a beautiful Gingko Biloba in this very location. The Class of 2005 has given two new trees to replace the lovely specimen lost in the heat of the fire. The Gingko tree has existed, unchanged on the planet Earth for over 150 million years, dating back to the Jurassic Period. The term living fossil used by Darwin in his Origin of Species of 1859 aptly fits the Gingko. It may be our oldest living seed plant, and represents a most precious and tenuous link between the present and the remote past. Individual trees may live longer than 3,000 years.
