

Instructions for in-person submission: Visit our office with your unexpired valid government-issued photo ID. Complete this form in the presence of a Financial Aid Staff Member. We will make a copy of your photo ID and upload the documentation to your financial aid file.

Instructions for mail submission: Present this blank form and a copy of an unexpired valid government-issued photo ID to a notary. Complete the 2nd page of this form in the presence of the notary. The notary will complete the notarization on page 2. Mail this form AND a copy of your photo ID to our Financial Aid Office.

To Be Signed at the Institution

The student must appear in person at Longwood University to verify his or her identity by presenting an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification, such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued photo identification, or U.S. passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student's photo ID that is annotated by the institution with the date it was received and reviewed and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student's ID.

To Be Signed in the Presence of a Notary

If the student is <u>unable to appear in person</u> at Longwood University to verify his or her identity, the student must provide:

- a) A copy of an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued photo identification, or U.S. passport that is acknowledged in the notary statement or that is presented to a notary; and
- b) An original notarized Statement of Educational Purpose, which is provided below, must be notarized. If the notary statement appears on a separate page than the Statement of Educational Purpose, there must be a clear indication that the Statement of Educational Purpose was the document notarized.
