B. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

There are multiple ways to document your circumstances. Please choose one of the following options:

1. AGENCY DOCUMENTATION

Provide documentation from a McKinney-Vento School District Liaison, a director/designee of a HUD-funded shelter, or a director/designee of a RHYA-funded shelter indicating one of the following:

Option I: I, _____, am considered an unaccompanied homeless youth as of July 1, 2021. This means that on or after July 1, 2021 I was living in a homeless situation, as defined by Section 725 of the McKinney-Vento Act, and was not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.

Option II: I, _____, am considered an unaccompanied, self-supporting youth at risk of homelessness as of July 1, 2021. This means that on or after July 1, 2021 I was not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian, am providing for my own living expenses, and am at risk of losing my housing.

2. ALTERNATIVE DOCUMENTATION

If you are unable to provide documentation from one of the agencies listed above, submit a statement which explains your current living situation, and whether you reside with a parent or guardian. Include information about your living options for school breaks and closures, and any other circumstances which may qualify you as an unaccompanied homeless youth or put you at risk of homelessness.

Please be aware that additional third-party documentation may be required. A counselor will contact you if anything further is needed after reviewing your personal statement.

Homelessness is defined as lacking in fixed, regular or adequate housing, which includes living in shelters, motels, cars or temporarily living with other people. The National Center of Homeless Education 1-800-308-2145 is available as a resource if you have questions.

C. CORRECTIONS NEEDED

If you are not homeless and do not qualify as an unaccompanied homeless youth or youth at risk of homelessness, you must correct the information on your FAFSA. In doing so you must provide your parent(s) financial information. You and one parent must sign and submit your corrected FAFSA.
